



Consultation on Admissions Arrangements for Autumn 2024 Entry

Consultation closes 30th January 2023

Oversubscription Criteria - Church Hill Infants School

1st	Children who are looked after and those children who were previously looked after children.
2nd	Pupils who will have an older brother or sister attending Church Hill Infant School at the same time who live in the same house. This will not apply to midterm admissions in year groups where the admission number has been reached.
3rd	Pupils starting Church Hill Infant school who have an older sibling attending Church Hill Junior school at the same time.
4th	Pupils who live in the catchment area at the time of application and admission.
5th	Pupils who have a serious medical condition or exceptional social or domestic needs that make it essential they attend the school requested. (Professional documentation confirming the situation must be submitted with the application).
6th	Pupils living nearest to the school measured in a straight line distance.

Oversubscription Criteria – Eastfield Primary School

1st	Looked after children and all previously looked after children, including those children who appear to have been in state care outside of England and ceased to be in state care as a result of being adopted.
2nd	Pupils who will have an older brother or sister attending Eastfield at the same time who live in the same house. This will not apply to mid-term admissions in year groups where the admission number has been reached.
3rd	Pupils who live in the catchment area at the time of application and admission.
4th	Pupils who have a serious medical condition or exceptional social or domestic needs that make it essential they attend the school requested. (Professional documentation confirming the situation must be submitted with the application).
5th	Pupils living nearest to the school measured in a straight line distance.

Oversubscription Criteria – The Pochin School

1st	Children who are looked after and those children who were previously looked after children.
2nd	Pupils who live in the catchment area at the time of application and admission.

3rd	Pupils who will have an older brother or sister attending The Pochin School at the same time who live in the same house. This will not apply to mid term admissions in year groups where the admission number has been reached.
4th	Pupils who are attending The Pochin Pre-School at point of application. Parents must make a separate application for a place at The Pochin School.
5th	Pupils who have a serious medical condition or exceptional social or domestic needs that make it essential they attend the school requested. (Professional documentation confirming the situation must be submitted with the application).
6th	Pupils living nearest to the school measured in a straight line distance.
